RULES OF COURT

Made under section 4

(The High Registries (Amendment) Rules 2005)

Citation 1. These Rules may be cited as the High Court Registries (Amendment) Rules 2005), and shall be read as one with the High Court Registries (Amendment) Rules 2001, together with the High Court Registries Rules, 1984 hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Rules" and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

Amendment of G.N. No. 63 of 2001 2. Rule 5F of the High Court Registries (Amendment) Rules, 2001 is hereby amended by deleting and replacing it with the following.

5 F(1) Except where both parties agree otherwise the trial of a suit in the Land Division of the High Court shall be with the aid of two assessors.

(2) Where in the course of the trial one or more of the assessors is absent the Court may proceed and conclude the trial with the remaining assessor or assessors as the case may be.
